Prescribing data for Non-medicated Nasal Sprays

Geographic coverage: All UK primary care prescribing, grouped by nation (England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland)

Time period: 12 individual months to June 2020

Units of measurement

Prescription items: the number of prescriptions for a product, which can be for any quantity of product

NIC: Net Ingredient Cost: the NHS reimbursement price paid to pharmacist at Drug Tariff price, net of any discounts or deductions

Quantity: the quantity / "volume" of product prescribed. For a nasal allergy spray, quantity=1 means 1 unit ie one spray. Care should be taken if comparing volume of products which have different presentations eg sprays vs nasal drops.
